PROSTITUTION IN THE NOVEL DAS ERSTE MAL UND IMMER WIEDER UND MÄNNER ROULETTE BY LISA MOOS

ABSTRACT

This study aims to describe: (1) the causes of Lisa's character to become a prostitute, (2) Lisa's character's life as a prostitute, and (3) Lisa's character's efforts to get out of the prostitution circle contained in the novel Das erste Mal und immer wieder and Männer Roulette by Lisa Moos.

The data sources of this research are the novel Das erste Mal und immer wieder and Männer Roulette by Lisa Moos. The data in this study are in the form of words, phrases, and sentences contained in the observational romance that contains information about the causes of the character to become a prostitute, a description of the character's life as a prostitute, and the character's efforts to get out of the prostitution circle. The validity of the data is obtained by considering the validity or semantic validity. Reliability or reliability is obtained through intrarater and interrater reliability.

The results showed that the factors that caused Lisa to become a prostitute namely when Lisa lost her father figure at a young age, the rape committed by Opa Hans, the rape by Marco, the mother who was sick, her failed marriage which caused her to lose her child, and also her high libido. During her life as a prostitute, Lisa experienced several domestic and public violence, which consisted of sexual violence, physical violence, emotional abuse, economic violence. In addition to the violence she endured, Lisa also lived a life as a high-class prostitute and also a street prostitute. There are 4 efforts for Lisa's character to get out of the prostitution circle, namely looking for a life partner, studying and working in the internet field, building an optimistic attitude, writing her life story into a romance.
