LEARNING EXPERIENCE OF LANGUAGE STUDENTS IN LEARNING MBKM FINE ARTS EDUCATION PROGRAM FBSB UNY

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ABSTRACT

The implementation of Merdeka Belajar Kampus Merdeka (MBKM) in tertiary institutions provides students with learning experiences between study programs with courses that are in line with their interests or those that are forced to take them due to many factors. It is interesting to see how students interpret this challenging learning because the fields of knowledge may not be the same as the major they are taking. This research is a qualitative study with a phenomenological approach that will look at textural description and structural description of the learning experiences of language students who take practical courses in fine arts education study programs. The research subjects are planned to have at least 10 students. Data collection techniques using interviews. Data analysis uses interpretative analysis. The results of this study show that first, all students involved show a strong interest and enthusiasm for fine arts. This interest encourages them to take fine arts study programs to develop art skills with enthusiasm. Second, participation in the fine arts MBKM has a positive impact on student learning experiences. In addition to enriching their artistic knowledge, they feel satisfaction and challenge in overcoming tough tasks. This experience also supports holistic self-development. Third, the importance of integrating art into education is clearly illustrated. Even though they come from diverse study program backgrounds, these students recognize the connection between fine arts and their main field of study. Through art courses, they understand that art can complement and deepen understanding in related fields of study. The use of art is also effective in communicating complex concepts, especially in language learning. This demonstrates the importance of an inclusive approach to arts education, recognizing the diversity of students' interests, benefits and abilities in utilizing arts courses.
