## MAKING THE COLLECTION OF UMBI PRODUCING COLLECTION GARDEN IN BEJI VILLAGE, PATUK GUNUNGKIDUL AS A STEPS FOR STRENGTHENING AGRICULTURE BASED ON LOCAL MATERIALS

## **ABSTRACT**

The purpose of the Community Service Program (PPM) is to provide a vehicle for training and making plant planting facilities for collecting tuber crops in the beji village, Patuk Gunungkidul sub-district. Beji Village is a pilot village for food independent villages in this sub-district. So that they can find out about the potential of many local tubers that are starting to be rarely used as a source of carbohydrates. The implementation of the PPM was preceded by the dissemination of the importance of understanding about conservation and the introduction of local tuber plants and the making of collection garden facilities including preparation of seeds, seeds and plangulation.
