CAREER MATURITY OF GUIDANCE AND COUNSELING'S UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS AT UNIVERSITAS NEGERI YOGYAKARTA

ABSTRACT

This study aimed at exploring of students career maturity at guidance and counseling department of Universitas Negeri Yogyakarta. The indicators of career maturity include the ability of self-assessment, job information, the ability of the destination selection, planning skills, and problem solving skills in career development tasks. The approach of the study is exploratory-descriptive research model. The subject of research that will be included in this study were undergraduate students of Guidance and Counseling, Universitas Negeri Yogyakarta. The conclusions that can be extracted from this study are; 1). the maturity of students career were in moderate level (M = 72.42). The number of students included in the moderate level is 69.3%, 2). A very large number of studens who identified as moderate level will be prone to immaturity career if not to intervene appropriately, and 3). there are no significant differences between both forces in career maturity (F = 0.855 and Sig = 0.427).
