

# **Ecology-based Artwork Technique Training as an Effort to Increase the Creativity of Elementary School Teachers in Klaten**

## **ABSTRACT**

This PPM activity aims to contribute significantly to efforts to increase the creativity of elementary school teachers through training on ecology-based art work techniques. The method used is a training activity with the stages of preparation, implementation and evaluation. The results of this activity are in the form of (1) observations before the activity, it was found that there were still limited knowledge and abilities of elementary school teachers in the creativity of art work techniques that made use of the diversity of materials in the surrounding environment, (2) training in art work techniques, which included forming, assembling, collage, montage, printing techniques and linking them to thematic learning, storytelling and environmental insight, (3) creativity in the form of ideas and the ability to work on various techniques for creating fine arts can be improved through this training activity.
