Profile of Family Resilience in the Rejowinangun Urban Village Kotagede Yogyakarta by Badraningsih L, Kokom Komariah, Marwanti, Siti Hamidah, Ezra Chica

ABSTRACT

Family resilience is a dynamic condition of the family that has tenacity, resilience, and physical, material, and mental abilities to live independently to develop themselves managing resources and problems in order to achieve a harmonious, prosperous, inner and outer life. This quantitative descriptive study was carried out in the Rejowinangun Urban Village which excelled in physical development. The purpose of this study is to get a picture of family resilience seen from the dimensions of a) the legality foundation of family integrity, b) physical resilience, c) economic resilience, d) psychological social security, e) social and cultural resilience

This study used a survey method, through a family resilience questionnaire from the Ministry of Women's Empowerment and Child Protection to families in the urban area of ??Rejowinangun Kotagede. Sample determination using RW based proportional random sampling. Data were analyzed according to quantitative descriptive according to categories.

The results obtained were obtained from the profile of family resilience seen from: a) the legality of the family integrity dimension by obtaining the average results for marriage legalities 6.81 (Very High R-IKK) and 6.39 with very high categories for birthweight. b) Physical Resilience scores 6.47 for food adequacy (Very High R-IKK) and 0.49 for nutritional adequacy (Very Low R-IKK). Families have health awareness (0.39: R-IKK Very Low). c) Economic resilience with an average home ownership indicator is self-owned houses (Very High R-IKK) and in terms of income, all husband and wife work and have an income of Rp 250,000.00 per month (Very High R-IKK). Family income can greatly assist in meeting needs (0.75 R-IKK Very Low). Parents do not understand the problems related to children's school fees, as evidenced by the very low R-IKK. Family resilience in the village of Rejowinangun in the continuity of children's education is very high (average value of 0.73 with R-IKK in the Very Low category). Ownership of cash funds in family savings is very high (5.61) which is used for the future. Family awareness in having insurance is very high (6.07). From the results of the study obtained data (d) psychology social security is very low (0.2) for parent violence against children. Family members have never been involved in legal matters (0.39 or very low). based on the results of the average value of participation of family members in religious activities in the environment with a value of 6.25 with an R-IKK value of 364.28 with the Very High category. It can be concluded that religious activities in addition to getting closer to the creator also draw closer to the surrounding community to build harmony in religion. Social psychology and socio-cultural resilience are expected to be a reference for the development of family resilience patterns with cultural variations.
