

TOUCH RUGBY TURNAMENT INTER ELEMENTARY, MIDDLE, AND HIGH SCHOOL IN DIY

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ABSTRACT

The enthusiasm of the participants on the Community Service (PPM) implementation of the Rugby sports tournament for Physical Education teachers conducted in 2016 makes the Rugby sport start to be recognized in some schools. Assistance from the PPM team has also been running quite well in some schools, so it is necessary to conduct advanced PPM to channel the students who have practiced Rugby.

Activities begin with promotions using posters and social media with free training offerings on Rugby touch games to schools to prepare for the Touch Rugby championship. The PPM activities took place on Saturday, September 19, 2017, with a total of 231 athletes from 11 schools, divided into 9 boys primary school group, 7 teams primary school, 4 teams and 3 team high schools. The activity went smoothly without any significant problems. The match system uses a round robin system that makes the activities more interesting because the team can play multiple times.

The outcomes of this activity are publications on social media such as Fans pages, Instagram both Rugby UNY and PRUI DIY and Rugby Indonesia official website. Moreover, the junior DIY Rugby team can follow the Bali Junior Rugby age group held in Bali, on 23-24 September 2017.

Another benefit of this activity is already a committee of benefits of the activity to learn how to be a committee, organizing an event or activities, socialization and other values. With that activity students will have experience that will be useful when becoming a Physical Education Teacher in Elementary School (SD), Junior High School and Senior High School (SMA) as well as in the community.
