The purposes of the community service program are: (1) improving the knowledge, insight and skills of junior high school teachers in Bantul Regency, Yogyakarta in designing a good and interesting PowerPoint presentation media in accordance with the principles of instructional message design. (2) improving the ability of junior high school teachers in Bantul Regency, Yogyakarta in utilizing the features on the PowerPoint media maximally. The activities undertaken in order to achieve these objectives are supported by the following training methods: (1) presentations and frequently asked questions, intended to enhance cognitive knowledge about the steps and principles in designing PowerPoint learning media, (2) The practice of making PowerPoint presentation media based on instructional message design, (3) mentoring of trainees, and (4) independent practice. The results of community service programs that have been implemented by Instructional Technology Study Program are: (1) improvement of teacher's knowledge and insight on power point learning media development in accordance with the principles of instructional design. This can be seen from the development of PowerPoint learning media that is produced, which has applied the principles of instructional design very well. (2) Generated power point learning media based on instructional message design by teachers in accordance with training objectives.
