## GOOD PRACTICE ARTICLE WRITING TRAINING LEARNING MODEL FOR FIRST MIDDLE SCHOOL TEACHERS IN SLEMAN DISTRICT

## **ABSTRACT**

The purpose of this activity is to equip Indonesian language teachers in junior high schools (SMP) throughout Sleman to be able to write and develop good practice articles on Indonesian language learning models. The form of this activity is training. Training activities are carried out systematically, from theoretical to practical activities, namely by using the lecture method, question and answer, practice, and brainstorming accompanied by mentoring. The training participants consisted of 34 Indonesian language teachers. PPM activities were carried out for 2 days, on June 9 and June 14 2023 offline and online (zoom meeting) and continued with assistance in writing good practice articles. PPM was well implemented. Participants actively participated in the activity from start to finish totaling 34 people. Participants came from 29 schools/agencies. Participants get theoretical material and practice writing good practice articles. Participants take part in the training actively and enthusiastically. The results of the activities show they can achieve results above the target. As much as 85% have been able to adequately understand and gain insight into the Indonesian language learning model. Meanwhile, as many as 28 participants have completed writing good practice articles. Based on the results of the implementation of these training activities, it can be concluded that the training activities in the PPM program this time went well and smoothly. Efforts to equip teachers with insight into good practice article writing have been achieved. Teachers have better understanding and writing skills regarding writing good practice articles on the Indonesian language learning model.
