ABSTRACT

This study aims to determine and capture potential athletes in wushu sports in children aged 7-14 years through wushu sports talent scouting tests.

The research to be conducted is a survey research. The research design used in this research is descriptive quantitative. The sample of this study were 40 boys and girls aged 7-14 years in the Special Region of Yogyakarta. Data collection techniques used were tests and measurements, including: anthropometric and biomotor tests. Anthropometric measurements include: height and weight, while biomotor tests include: flexibility, strength, agility, speed, and power. The data analysis technique used is the percentage. The result of this research is that the majority of research subjects are quite talented in wushu with a percentage of 64.81%.
