TRAINING ON THE PREPARATION OF JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL TEACHING MATERIALS IN THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC FOR SOCIAL STUDIES TEACHERS OF SMP CILACAP AND KEBUMEN, CENTRAL JAVA

ABSTRACT

Learning during a pandemic has several problems, one of which is the availability of teaching materials. This service aims to; 1) develop teacher competence in preparing teaching materials in the form of modules during the pandemic, 2) produce teaching materials in the form of modules during the pandemic for social studies subjects.

The training was held online in November 2020, with a total of 42 teachers from Cilacap and Kebumen districts, Central Java. At the initial stage, there was an equalization of perceptions and FGD of the service team with the MGMP management of the two districts, followed by the preparation of teaching materials, and the implementation of training. The training is carried out online using zoom meeting media with lecture methods, questions and answers, workshops, and mentoring.

The results of the training were; 1) 40 teachers passed the training, so they had an increased ability to develop distance learning modules for social studies subjects. 2) A total of 40 themes of distance learning social studies modules for grades VII, VIII, and IX were produced by the participants. The module was then returned to the District MGMP for further development
