

The Influence of the Role of Parents and the Role of the Coach on Character DIY Junior Tennis Player

ABSTRACT

This study aims to determine the effect of the role of parents and the role of coaches on the character of junior tennis players in Yogyakarta. This research is a type of correlational research with a quantitative approach to determine the relationship between two or more variables. Data collection techniques through questionnaires. The sample of this study was 32 respondents of junior tennis athletes in the DIY region which were taken by purposive sampling technique. The instruments in this study have been tested for validity and reliability, and have been consulted by experts. The data analysis technique used multiple regression analysis. Based on the results (T-Test) the significant value of the parental role variable was $0.000 < 0.05$ and the coach role was $0.000 < 0.05$. This means that partially the role of parents affects the character of junior tennis players and the role of coaches affects the character of junior tennis players. The results (Test F) obtained a significance value of 0.000, so it can be concluded that the role of parents and the role of coaches simultaneously affect the character of junior tennis players in DIY. In addition, the result of the R Square® value is 0.719, which means that 71.9% of the character of junior tennis players in DIY is influenced by the role of parents and the role of the coach
