IMPROVEMENT OF WOMEN ROLE IN YARD MANAGEMENT FOR MEDICAL PLANTS IN JETIS SURUH, DONOHARJO, NGAGLIK, SLEMAN, YOGYAKARTA SPECIAL REGION

ABSTRACT

The training in this service activity aims to: (1) Increase women's knowledge about the yard, (2) Improve the ability of women as a group that has activities related to the proper utilization and management of the yard, (3) Increase women's participation in yard management. The target audience for service activities was PKK womens in Jetis Suruh, with a target of 30 trainees. In the implementation of service activities used the lecture and practice methods. Lectures are used to explain the knowledge of the basic concepts of the yard, the problems of the yard from the local to global scale, the forms of positive actions in overcoming the problems of the yard, the management of the yard for medical plants, while the practice is done to process the plants into turmeric. The supporting factor of the activity was the support of the training participants and the womens of the Village Head, while the inhibiting factor of the activity was the limited implementation time. Overall service activities can be said to be good, seen from the success of the target number of trainees (80%), achievement of training objectives (80%), achievement of planned material targets (80%), and the ability of participants in mastering the material (75%). Service activities can improve: (a) training participants' knowledge and abilities about yard management for medical plants, (b) participation of training participants in processing yard plants into medical drinks.
