

TRAINING OF CLASSROOM ACTION RESEARCH (PTK) FOR TEACHERS IN SMP NEGERI 15 YOGYAKARTA CITY

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ABSTRACT

This community service activity aims to motivate teachers at SMP Negeri 15 Yogyakarta City in increasing their understanding of classroom action research (PTK), as well as technical practical skills regarding classroom action research (PTK) which includes: (1) motivating teachers of SMP Negeri 15 Yogyakarta City in conducting Class Action Research (PTK), (2) increasing the understanding of 15 Yogyakarta City Public Middle School teachers in conducting classroom action research (PTK), and (3) increasing the technical abilities and skills of 15 City Public Middle School teachers Yogyakarta in conducting Classroom Action Research (PTK). The target of this activity is teachers at SMP Negeri 15 Yogyakarta City who have the will and ability to be trained in classroom action research (PTK). The selection and determination of the targets for this training have rational-strategic considerations, an effort to increase the understanding of teachers at SMP Negeri 15 Kota Yogyakarta regarding classroom action research (PTK) and 25 teachers of SMP Negeri 15 Kota Yogyakarta will be taken, the training will be carried out for 3 days or at least 16 hours of meetings.

The activity methods in this training are lectures, discussions, questions and answers and simulations and are carried out offline and provided online assistance. Evaluation of activities is carried out during the process and at the end of the training, in the aspects of achieving training objectives and also organizing the training. Evaluation of the process and results (achievement of training objectives) is carried out using a questionnaire. Evaluation of aspects of training implementation is also carried out by administering questionnaires. Indicators of success in implementing classroom action research (PTK) training for teachers at SMP Negeri 15 Yogyakarta City include 2 methods, namely: (1) Evaluation during the training process, and (2) post-training evaluation.

Class Action Research training activities at Child Friendly Schools (SRA) were successfully carried out on 7-8 June 2023 smoothly, the activities were opened by the Principal of SMP Negeri 15 Yogyakarta City. All participants and the PPM team participated enthusiastically. On the first day there were 25 teachers who attended. The first day of the meeting was filled with activities with presentation of material related to types of research and classroom action research. The second day's activities were carried out with presentation of material and discussions related to classroom action research at SMP 15 as a child-friendly school organizer. The activity began with a presentation of case studies of child-friendly schools. Evaluation of PPM activities in aspects of training implementation was carried out by giving questionnaires to participants with the results of the training process being that more than 100% of participants were satisfied with the knowledge and skills that had been provided by the UNY PPM TEAM
