Tracer Study Alumni of Undergraduate PGSD Penjas Study Program FIK UNY to Welcome PTN BH

ABSTRACT

The purpose of this study was to determine the traces and responses of alumni which include: 1) Tuition Financing, 2) Employment, 3) Time to Get a Job, 4) Type of Workplace, 5) Suitability of Field of Study with Work, 6) Study Methods for Study Programs, and 7) Study Program/UNY Contribution to the Competition.

This research is a quantitative descriptive study, with a survey approach. The subjects of the research were 224 alumni of the PGSD Physical Education Study Program who graduated from 2018-2022. The instrument used is a questionnaire at the university. Descriptive analysis was carried out using the frequency distribution tabulation technique and histogram, and was equipped with a narrative explanation.

The results of the study are: 1) The largest tuition fee is at their own expense, as many as 163 students or 72.77%, 2) At the time of college, 182 students (81.25%) were not working, 3) A total of 99 alumni (44, 20%) got a job after graduating from college, 4) 49 people (21.88%) worked in private schools/PT, 5) 72 people or 32.14% said it was very suitable between the field of study and work, 6) learning methods the one who gets the highest score is field work, and 7) the competency of the graduate who gets the highest score is tolerance.
