COMMUNITY ELECTRIC WHEEL CHAIR TRAINING AND SERVICE DIFABLE IN YOGYAKARTA

ABSTRACT

Difabel refers to the limited role of persons with disabilities in carrying out activities of daily life due to their disability. The condition of a person with a disability can also be improved with tools that enable him to carry out his activities as before. In accordance with the contents of the Constitution 8 of 2016 Article 1 points 10 and 11 which state that assistive devices are objects that function to assist the independence of Persons with Disabilities in carrying out daily activities and objects that function to optimize the function of the limbs of Persons with Disabilities based on recommendations from medical personnel. One of the disability aids is a wheelchair. Wheelchairs used by people with disabilities aim to facilitate the mobility of people with disabilities to mobilize activities. Which means any activity that requires moving places using a wheelchair. Because people with disabilities have limitations in their activities, there is a need for training to carry out maintenance and service of electric wheelchairs.

The results of the PPM implementation on training in the maintenance and service of electric wheelchairs for disabled communities in Yogyakarta went well. The PPM implementation assisted by partners from United Cerebral Palsy Roda for Humanity (UCPRUK) supports and broadens participants with disabilities in maintaining and repairing electric wheelchairs. Some participants are able to carry out wheelchair maintenance and service.
