

KNOWLEDGE, ATTITUDE AND ADOLESCENT SEXUAL BEHAVIOR MEMBERS OF ADOLESCENT COUNSELING INFORMATION CENTER AT SMA N 2 BANTUL

ABSTRACT

Sexual behavior is a major problem related to various cases of juvenile delinquency. Delinquency, especially sexual problems that occur from year to year show an increase. This research was conducted with the aim to: (1) determine adolescent sexual knowledge members of PIK-R at SMAN 2 Bantul, and (2) determine adolescent attitudes and sexual behaviors member PIK-R at SMAN 2 Bantul. The study design was a descriptive study. The research variables are knowledge juvenile, adolescent attitude, and sexual behavior of adolescents. Research conducted at SMAN 2 Bantul, of the month from April to October 2016. Year study population was all students SMA N 2 Bantul, amounting to 830 people. Samples were students of class X IPA7, IPS2 class X, XI IPA6, and XI IPS1, the whole amounted to 111 people. Data were collected through observations, questionnaires, and documentation. The research data were subsequently processed and analyzed descriptively. The results showed that: (1) sexual knowledge respondents was "adequate" (55.9%), the "good" (40.5%), and "less" (3.6%), (2) (a) attitude sexual all respondents (100%) is "negative" or tend to avoid, avoid, and hate the things related to premarital sex, and (b) the sexual behavior of respondents to express affection to a boyfriend was holding hands (55.9%), smell cheek (22.1%), and kiss the lips (7.4%). All respondents (100%) had never expressed affection for girlfriend by touching sensitive body parts, petting, oral sex, anal sex, and sexual intercourse.
