Online learning that must be done by teachers in the current pandemic era makes PAUD teachers have to be creative. The making of Pop Up media as a medium for stimulating early childhood development has not been fully mastered by PAUD teachers. One of the difficulties faced by teachers is that they do not have much experience in making Pop Up media and there is not much experience in uploading learning media online on YouTube. Online learning that is currently taking place has not been uploaded much on YouTube so that many teachers and parents complain that their cellphone memory capacity is no longer able to store information from the teacher. Learning media that are unique and challenge children's curiosity will be more interesting to do at home so that it is hoped that children will not easily get bored studying at home with their parents. This study aims to improve the ability of early childhood educators about making three-dimensional Pop Up media while providing the experience of uploading learning media online on YouTube. The subjects of this study were 30 PAUD educators in Depok District, Sleman Regency. Data were collected by means of observation before and after training. The results of this study indicate that after participating in the training, the subjects experienced an increase in the three materials provided, namely understanding of learning media, making Pop Up media and managing learning media online.
