IMPLEMENTATION TRAINING OF CURRICULUM 2013 FOR THE TEACHER PRIMARY PHYSICAL EDUCATION KKG YOGYA IN WEST

ABSTRACT

Goals to be achieved through this training is to provide knowledge and skills in the preparation of facilities and infrastructure development of physical education as an effort to improve the quality of teaching physical education. Method of activities with the two approaches. First, the theoretical approach which consists of exposure of the material, discussion, and frequently asked questions. Second, the approach consists of drafting practice. RPP physical education lessons. Each approach ends with the evaluation of the learning program. The materials delivered include: delivery of materials lecture teaching model of physical education, the scope of elementary school physical education, physical education and infrastructure development. Indicators of success is characterized by (1) high motivation of the participants in following the activities, (2) has knowledge and skills about the development of physical education infrastructure, and (3) the large number of participants who are able to make physical education learning lesson plans. This community service activity program can run smoothly with 37 participants followed by physical education teacher at West Yogya. PPM program is implemented today Saturday, November 2, 2013. Location Service at Teachers Working Group (KKG) Penjas primary school Yogya. Total long devotion to 22 hours, consisting of 10 hours of training and monitoring / task independently for 12 hours. Based on the results of the training development of infrastructure physical education which consists of making the syllabus and lesson plans, the results are as follows: (1) there are 6 groups or 30 people who managed to make lesson plans teaching physical education, and (2) are one group or 7 participants RPP has not managed to make physical education learning.
