

TRAINING ON THE PREPARATION OF INDEPENDENT CURRICULUM LEARNING TOOLS FOR SMP PSYCHOLOGY TEACHERS, KULON PROGO DISTRICT

ABSTRACT

The implementation of the Merdeka Curriculum in schools has been carried out since 2021, especially in Driving Schools which implemented it in their schools first. Along with the implementation of the Independent Curriculum, many outreach efforts have been made to teachers to ensure implementation in schools. One of them is training in preparing learning tools. However, teachers who are members of the MGMP IPS SMP/MTs Kulon Progo Regency still feel the need to be guided in making learning tools used in the Independent Curriculum. For this reason, the service team from the Social Sciences Education Department intends to help the MGMP IPS SMP/MTs Kulon Progo Regency to provide additional training regarding the preparation of learning tools that will be used in Independent Curriculum-based social studies learning in their schools. Activities will be carried out through offline training for 40 SMP/MTs social studies teachers in Kulon Progo Regency. The training course will focus on preparing the Learning Objectives Flow (ATP), Learning Outcomes (CP), Teaching Modules, as well as understanding differentiated learning including how to design learning evaluations. The service team consisting of 1 chairman, 3 members, and assisted by 5 students will conduct training at three meetings to accommodate teacher needs. Through this service, teachers who are members of the MGMP IPS SMP Kulon Progo Regency not only understand more about the implementation of the Independent Curriculum, but also build optimism to fully implement the Independent Curriculum in schools. The expected benefit for partners is that SMP/MTs social studies teachers in Kulon Progo Regency are able to develop learning tools to support social studies learning in their respective schools.
