## STRENGTHENING DIGITAL LITERACY IN FAMILIES IN THE ERA OF DISRUPTION

## **ABSTRACT**

The development of science and technology today has made the world seem without borders. Various communication activities can be carried out virtually, making everything easier, shorter and closer. Digital media makes it easier for each user to share information with each other. However, people's lack of understanding of digital media results in misuse which has consequences for personal and social life. In fact, not all individuals, including teenagers, who use communication technology have good digital literacy. Inappropriate use of digital communication technology can have a negative impact on the continuity of individual and social life. Therefore, digital literacy is needed in society, especially children and teenagers, to filter the information presented on social media. Digital literacy in teenagers will be closely related to the family environment which is the first and main source of learning for children. The role of parents as a component in the family itself has quite a big influence on the upbringing and care of children. The aim of this research is to understand the digital literacy process within the family, especially among teenage children in the era of disruption. The research method uses qualitative research with a phenomenological approach. Data analysis was carried out in this research using the phenomenology data analysis method or known as FDA. The analysis stages include data reduction, data analysis and drawing conclusions.
