## Entrepreneurship Management Training in Kampung Emas, Dusun Krapyak Seyegan

## **ABSTRACT**

Entrepreneurship management is crucial for the entire community, including the residents of Kampung Emas, Dusun Krapyak Seyegan, who have potential in the field of entrepreneurship. However, not all residents of Kampung Emas, Dusun Krapyak Seyegan, have an understanding of entrepreneurship management and lack the skills to manage entrepreneurship in their daily lives. Therefore, there is a need for training for the community on the concept of entrepreneurship management, business planning, service management, business expansion strategies, glimpses of successful mompreneurs, and facilitation techniques.
