

# **Strengthening the Instructional Models of Physical Education Based on 2013 Curriculum for Elementary School Teachers**

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## **ABSTRACT**

Physical Education (PE) learning has developed rapidly, followed by the use of instructional models that emphasize more on the development of student aspects as a whole in accordance with the demands of the current curriculum.
