

TALOKWOHMOJO VILLAGE LITERACY DEVELOPMENT TO INCREASE PUBLIC READING INTEREST

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ABSTRACT

The general objective of the KKN-PPM is to empower the community in an effort to alleviate illiteracy through the establishment of literacy villages. Through the KKN-PPM program students and teams empower village potential towards knowledge-literate villages.

The KKN-PPM activity was held in Talokwohmojo Village, Ngawen District, Blora Regency. The method of implementing the program in this activity is through the stages of preparing cooperation with the Maryati Park social institution for the utilization of social institution facilities for the community. The next stage is structuring one part of Maryati Park for community libraries. Teams and students organize and equip facilities into representative reading rooms. The next stage is to make the management of the park read Maryati Park by Village Youth in management. This is his hope that after the KKN program is finished the Reading Park management activities will be carried out by the Youth of Talokwohmojo Village.

The expected outcome or outcome of the KKN-PPM activities is that villagers have increased reading interest. Taman Bacaan is crowded with visits by teenagers and children, even parents who also participate in various activities
