ABSTRACT

Devotion to this community aims to provide family records management training to improve public awareness in storing and organizing the archives well and correctly. Community service was held on 22-23 March 2019. This activity is expected to increase public awareness of the storage and setup of good and true family archives. With increased public awareness of the storage and setup of family archives with good and right indirectly skills and knowledge of the management of family archives also increased.

The method used in this community devotion activity is 1) lecture, this method is used to convey explanation to participants about the material of family archive. 2) Discussion, this method is done to explore issues related to the material and to dig problems-problems that are often encountered in the process of storing family archives. 3) practices and mentoring.

Based on the results of the evaluation of PPM activities that carried out the results that (1) All participants understand with family archives (2) All participants understand the material of the Storage System family archive (3) as much as 89.66% or 29 participants understand And as many as 10.34% or 3 of the participants did not understand the family records management material (4) The participation rate of PPM participants as much as 96.67% or 29 attendance. Hopefully after the participants get the knowledge and practice about the management of family archives, participants can transmit to the outside community. This can make more and more people aware that the importance of managing a family archive is good and correct.
