TEACHERS 'UNDERSTANDING AND KNOWLEDGE OF SPORT AND HEALTH EDUCATION IN INCLUSION SCHOOLS IN SPECIAL REGION OF YOGYAKARTA

ABSTRACT

Research purposes: to determine the level of knowledge of physical education teachers on adaptive physical education material in inclusive schools Yogyakarta City.

Research methods: This study uses a descriptive quantitative approach. This research was conducted at the State Inclusion Elementary School of Yogyakarta City with the number of research subjects as many as 12 physical education teachers in 6 elementary schools. The test used is a knowledge test with true and false questions. The validity test uses the Pearson product moment formula. It is known that from 30 questions there are 2 questions that fail, so that the test used in the study is 28 questions. The data analysis technique used quantitative descriptive analysis.

Research result: the level of knowledge of physical education teachers on adaptive physical education material in the State inclusion school of Yogyakarta City is in the very good category of 0%, the good category is 16.7%, the moderate category is 50%, and the poor category is 33.3%. The level of knowledge of physical education teachers on adaptive physical education material is explained by 6 aspects, namely: 1) aspects remembering most of them are in the 50% deficient category, 2) aspects of understanding in the sufficient category are 33.3%, 3) aspects of applying are mostly in the very category. good at 41.7%, 4) aspects of the analysis were mostly in the good category of 58.3%, 5) aspects assessed most of them were in the very good category at 58.3% and 6) the creative aspects were mostly in the good category by 50%
