TRAINING TO DEVELOPING SKILL PERCEPTION OF ELEMENTARY SCHOOL STUDENTS THROUGH GAME SPORTS LEARNING

ABSTRACT

The training conducted by the UNY FIK PPM Team was carried out with the background of the level of knowledge of PPM participants in terms of motor perception material, elementary PJOK teachers in Sewon Subdistrict still varied, and the purpose of this service to provide teachers in elementary school had sufficient understanding of the material motoric perception that this ability is very important for elementary school children. The method used in problem solving in this service is using the method of speech, discussion, demonstration and practice. The audience or participants of this training are elementary PJOK teachers in Sewon Subdistrict, Bantul with a total of 31 people. The results obtained an increase in the average test results of participants' knowledge from the average score of 61.29 to an average score of 75.80. The increase was one of the factors that had been given material that had been given before the post test. The conclusions from the results of this service can be categorized as good and smooth, this is evidenced by the enthusiasm of the participants, and also the impressions and messages of participants who are positively grateful for the activity and request that the collaboration continue with its variations.
