## Text-Based Instruction Learning Material Development Workshops for English Language Teachers

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## ABSTRACT

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This Community Service Activities (PPM) takes the form of workshops in the development of learning materials based on text-based instructions for English teachers who are members of the Muhammadiyah Teacher Forum in the Special Region of Yogyakarta. This activity was carried out by the UNY PPM Team consisting of a group of lecturers assisted by two students of the English Education Study Program. This activity aims to increase the knowledge of English teachers to develop text-based learning that is in accordance with the learning steps mandated by the current curriculum and integrates character education, higher order thinking skills and 21st century learning skills.

This PPM activity was carried out for 15 days consisting of workshop activities which were attended by English teachers at the SMA/SMK level, English teachers at the junior high school and elementary English teachers. The workshop participants consisted of 12 workshop participants for high school teachers, 14 workshop participants for junior high school teachers and 20 workshop participants for elementary school teachers. The training was carried out online due to conditions in the midst of the Covid 19 pandemic. The training methods used were webinars, uploading materials, discussion forums, workshops, and individual presentations packaged online using the Zoom application.

The results of this PPM activity are: (1) the participants experience an increase in knowledge and skills in the development of text-based learning materials (2) the participants feel the benefits of PPM activities (3) the participants can develop learning tools in accordance with the provisions of text-based teaching.
