

DEVELOPMENT OF TIRTOHARGO VILLAGE AS A COASTAL VILLAGE SUPPORT TO BANTUL SOUTH COAST TOURISM DESTINATION YOGYAKARTA

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ABSTRACT

The PkM KKN program conducted by UNY students aims to: (1) improve skills in making food management based on local ingredients; (2) can increase the skills of farming communities in crab cultivation; and (3) assisting the Tirtohargo village community in utilizing the Opak river flow as a tourist destination development.

The methods used in the development of this Tirtohargo village tourism village include: (1) interactive lectures, (2) question and answer, (3) demonstrations, (4) practice, (5) and assistance. While the approach used in these activities uses the andragogy education model, namely an active two-way discussion approach. The results of the activities carried out activity evaluation to determine the level of success of the program.

The results of this PkM KKN activity are: (1) it has produced a special food "dodol made from aloe vera", with a very enchanting texture and product appearance; (2) has increased the knowledge and skills of residents in cultivating crabs; and (3) Students have played an active role in helping to create a canoe tourist destination as a tourist attraction for the enchanting Opak River.
