The character education program and entrepreneurship education has a very important role to develop in school. This study aims to determine: 1) planning entrepreneurcharacter education in Islamic Junior High School Al Mubtadi-ien; 2) the implementation of entrepreneurcharacter education in Islamic Junior High School Al Mubtadi-ien; 3) evaluation of entrepreneurcharacter education in Islamic Junior High School Al Mubtadi-ien; 4) the values ??of the characters embedded in the entrepreneur character education in Islamic Junior High School Al Mubtadi-ien; 5) the driving factor entrepreneur character education in Islamic Junior High School Al Mubtadi-ien; 6) inhibit factorentrepreneur character education in Islamic Junior High School Al Mubtadi-ien;
