Empowerment of Extracurricular Assistant Teachers at SMAN 1 Kebumen through Talent Scouting Training for Talents & Interests in the Field of Reasoning & Sports

ABSTRACT

The talents & interests of high school students have not been well identified in partner schools. This has an impact on schools which experience problems selecting students as school representatives in each talent and interest championship competition. This condition is further exacerbated because there has been no effort to periodically socialize the search for students' talents & interests in partner schools. Teachers and partner schools do not yet have sufficient skills to carry out talent scouting for talents & interests. This activity aims to: 1) Provide insight into techniques and strategies in exploring students' talents & interests at school for teachers at SMAN 1 Kebumen, 2) Improve talent scouting skills in the field of reasoning and sports for teachers at SMAN 1 Kebumen, and 3) Increasing the role of teachers in preparing talented students for championship competitions in reasoning and sports. This activity was held using lecture methods, information discussions, workshops and limited dissemination to explore students' talents and interests. The results of the activity show that teachers in partner schools have adequate insight and skills in conducting talent scouting for talents & interests, teachers are able to carry out talent scouting in the fields of reasoning and sports, and teachers in partner schools have been able to play a role in preparing participants. students who are equipped for championship competitions in the fields of reasoning and sports.
