

CHILD REPORTER TRAINING FOR MUHAMMADIYAH ELEMENTARY STUDENTS SURYOWIJAYAN, YOGYAKARTA

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ABSTRACT

The purpose of this community service program is to provide training to become a young reporter for students of SD Muhammadiyah Suryowijayan, Yogyakarta. In addition, this activity can be used as a means of increasing the competence of students in producing journalistic products.

The target audience for this program are SD Muhammadiyah Suryowijayan students in Yogyakarta. Participants were all grade 4 and 5 students. In its implementation, the implementation team collaborated with the Principal of SD Muhammadiyah Suryowijayan Yogyakarta. Journalistic training methods using lectures, discussions, workshops, mentoring tutorials, and production of results.

This training activity was successfully carried out Monday, 24 July 2023 in the seminar room, WS Rendra Building, 2nd floor, Faculty of Languages, Arts and Culture, Yogyakarta State University. Activities start at 08.00 WIB until 12.25 WIB. This training was attended by 42 students, 4 accompanying teachers, and 2 reporters from Adi TV and Radar Jogja. The training activities were divided into three sessions. In the first session of the activity, participants were given material on the Fundamentals of Journalism delivered by Ahmad Wahyudin, M.Hum. The second and third sessions were delivered by Anggita Rachmawati, a practitioner from Adi TV who presented material on News Writing Techniques and the practice of being a reporter. The results of the young reporter training were obtained after the students practiced writing and presenting news. The results of the training are 12 video reports about waste selection.
