## Validity, Reliability, and Relevance of The Kemp-Vincent Rally Tennis Test to The Tennis Play Skills of Students of FIK UNY

## **ABSTRACT**

This research aims to investigate the validity, reliability, and relevance of the Kemp-Vincent Rally Tennis Test to the Tennis Play Skills of students of FIK UNY. This research was a descriptive research. The data were collected by using test and measurement. The subject of this research was the students of FIK UNY who already taken the Tennis course by using purposive sampling technique and quota sampling that is 34 students (male: 22, female: 12). The results are: (1) the validity of the Kemp-Vincent Rally Tennis Test to the Tennis Play Skills of the male students is – 0,772, while for the female students is -0,794, (2) the reliability of the test for the male and female students is 0,963 and 0,941, subsequently, (3) the relevance of the test to the male students is good and excellent while for the female students is moderate and good. The conclusion is that The Kemp-Vincent Rally Tennis Test has a good validity, reliability, and relevance so that it could be used as an instrument to measure the Tennis play skills of the students of FIK UNY.
