

# **EVALUATION OF Badminton ATHLETE DEVELOPMENT IN olympiade TOKYO JAPAN**

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## **ABSTRACT**

This study aims to evaluate the long-term coaching of badminton national training athletes. The method in this research is qualitative methods. The instruments used were tape recorder, camera and a questionnaire. The data was collected through depth interview, observation, documentation and questionnaires. The technique of data analysis was done descriptively. Subject of the research includes administration, coaches, badminton athletes in Klaten district. The subjects of this research include badminton administrators, coaches, and athletes. The research was conducted at the Cipayung badminton national. The sample was taken by purposive sampling of 11 people consisting of: four PP PBSI administrators, three coaches, and four athlete representatives. The results showed that (a) the vision, mission and objectives of the organization were written and could be carried out optimally by the organization; (b) human resources for coaching are filled by professional experts who are competent in badminton; (c) very adequate funding from both the government and other funding sources such as sponsorship and support from each badminton club and the public; (d) the appreciation is good enough, but there are some thoughts related to old age security if not an athlete; (e) the coaching strategy is running well and levels from junior level up to being an accomplished athlete fostered through badminton sports clubs; (f) a highly programmed training and competition program with the support of professional coaches and a fair and healthy competition with a balanced reward-punishment and a fair system of promotion of degradation. One of the obstacles in this coaching is the lack of optimization of sports science and technology from the management which should be a major part of the badminton coaching process
