The training material is in the form of theoretical concepts about games both during the learning process and outside the learning process, an understanding of the types of traditional games, the development of traditional games in learning and continued with assistance by the service team to develop traditional learning games.

The result of this training is that more than 90% of Ceria Kotagede's group teachers' understanding of the development of traditional games in the learning process has improved. More than 80% of the ability of Ceria Kotagede group teachers in traditional games in the learning process has improved.
