

Counseling Practice Training Using Conference Methods for Pamong Teachers and DPL of PPL in Sleman

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ABSTRACT

This training is motivated by the desire to help improve the quality of PPL guidance in schools involving teachers pamong, DPL PPL, and students praktikan. The current model is still incidental and unstructured. The tendency to establish students doing classroom teaching practices, rather than getting them ready and understanding the nature of being an educator. Students need more just to meet the prescribed teaching hours, but also other information related to the preparation, implementation, and evaluation of learning. Students also need information and knowledge related to school activities outside of learning. Therefore, good collaboration between the three elements is required.

This activity involves teachers of junior high school subjects throughout Sleman Regency and Yogyakarta City, amounting to 30 people. This training activity took place in Seminar Room 2nd floor of GK I FBS UNY. The training was conducted for three meetings, 16, 19 and 23 September 2017. The methods used included workshops, practices, and demonstrations. In addition, there are mentoring conducted by the Team of Servants to the schools.

This activity produces a reflection journal. Participants are quite adult following this training and there are no significant obstacles. At the time of facilitation it was found that teachers and DPL PPL had already begun to change the way to conduct PPL guidance by using the Conference method.
