TWORKSHOP OF LITERATION-BASED CULTURE COLLABORATIVE STRATEGY FOR JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOLS IN BANTUL DISTRICT

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ABSTRACT

This activity aims to provide opportunities for schools to understand and apply the culture of literacy in schools. adequately change the learning paradigm according to the demands of the 2013 Curriculum and provide opportunities for teachers to understand Graduates Competency Standards, Content Standards, as well as Core Competencies and Basic Competencies, map Basic Competencies, into learning indicators, as well as concepts and or principles of learning that apply the mode disclosure-based learning or research (discovery / inquiry learning) and learning that results in problem-based work (project based learning). The method of activity used is training and workshops using the andragogy approach.
