

Efforts to Improve Fishery Products Processing Skills For Mothers Members of PKK Dukuh VIII, Kamal Wetan, Margomulyo, Seyegan, Sleman

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ABSTRACT

Training activities have been conducted with the aim to provide the skills of processing fishery products (meatballs and *mpek-mpek*) for the members of PKK Dukuh VIII Kamal Wetan, Margomulyo, Seyegan, Sleman. This activity is carried out by way of counseling and processing practices with guidance from the executor of the activity. Counseling includes: how to choose a good fish, how to store fish, and ways of processing fish into meatballs and fish *mpek-mpek*. The process of direct processing is guided by the Implementing Team in collaboration with experts from the Department of Marine and Fisheries of DIY Province. The event was held on 27 August 2017 with 28 participants. Activities went well with enthusiastic support from participants. Most participants can understand the training materials and are motivated to apply the training results at home. But only a small number of participants who are motivated to entrepreneurship with processed fish products. Advanced intensive guidance is needed on the residents so that the impact of training activities is real and optimal. Factors that supporting and inhibiting the implementation of the activities discussed in the article.
