COMPARISON ANALYSIS OF BAN-PT AND LAM ACCREDITATION IN MEASURING PERFORMANCE AND GOVERNANCE OF STUDY PROGRAMS

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ABSTRACT

Accreditation is an assessment activity to determine the eligibility of Study Programs and Universities. Accreditation is carried out for Study Programs and Universities based on the National Higher Education Standards. Until the end of 2021, the accreditation of both tertiary institutions and study programs will be carried out by the National Accreditation Board for Higher Education (BAN-PT). However, since January 1, 2022, Study Program Accreditation has been carried out by the Independent Accreditation Institute (LAM). This transfer of accreditation authority certainly has an impact on the implementation of accreditation both in terms of requirements, accreditation procedures and the criteria used. LAM began operating on March 31, 2022 so that since then the authority of BAN-PT is no longer to carry out accreditation of study programs whose accreditation will expire in 2022-2023. Universities must adapt to new rules and procedures and criteria for re-accreditation. This is interesting for researchers, in this case the UNY Higher Education Development Centre (P2MPT), which has the main task and function of overseeing the internal and external quality assurance system, to conduct a study of the criteria for the LAM accreditation instrument which is of course different from the criteria for BAN-PT. The benefits of this study will greatly assist the study program in carrying out re-accreditation.
