LAW ENFORCEMENT IN IMPLEMENTATION OF REGIONAL REGULATION NO 5/2019 ABOUT PROVINCE SPATIAL PLAN YOGYAKARTA SPECIAL REGION

ABSTRACT

The purpose of the research entitled Law enforcement in the implementation of Regional Regulation Number 5 of 2019 concerning the Regional Spatial Plan of the Special Region of Yogyakarta, this is to find out and analyze the implementation of Regional Regulation Number 5 of 2019 concerning the Regional Spatial Plan of the Special Region of Yogyakarta, to find out law enforcement related to control, especially in the use of space and the law enforcement process for violations of spatial planning is very important in revitalizing the spatial planning map in the Special Region of Yogyakarta. And to find out and analyze the obstacles in enforcing the law on Regional Regulation Number 5 of 2019 concerning the Regional Spatial Planning of the Special Region of Yogyakarta

The research method used in this research is socio-legal research with a qualitative approach. Primary data is in the form of laws and regulations governing the Law on Spatial Planning, related to law enforcement and Regional Regulation Number 5 of 2019 concerning Spatial Planning for the Special Region of Yogyakarta. Secondary data in the form of official documents, for example, minutes of meetings, socialization activities and other urgent documents. Data collection will be done by interviewing techniques, and documentation. The research subjects were determined purposively, from the criteria obtained the research subjects were two staff in the field of law on the use of handling problems and supervising the spatial planning of DISPETARU DIY, 1 staff in the field of law at DISPETARU Yogyakarta City, 1 staff in the field of Law at DISPETARU, Sleman Regency. The data analysis technique will be carried out inductively through the stages of data reduction, categorization and data unitization. Next, general conclusions will be drawn.

The results of the study obtained that the implementation contained in Regional Regulation No. 5 of 2019, which has the goal of realizing DIY, which is a world-class center of education, culture, and a leading tourist destination by prioritizing integrated development between sectors based on disaster mitigation, special spatial planning of DIY, and the environment through quality and sustainable spatial planning. The spatial planning must also have an integrated national, provincial and regional spatial planning. Law enforcement on the implementation of the DIY Regional Regulation number 5 of 2019 concerning the 2019-2039 DIY RTRW that is still not optimal. . especially related to the factor of legal regulations, there are incomplete laws and regulations that are the reference for spatial control, namely the district government in DIY has not completely issued the RDTR (Tencana Details Spatial). In terms of law enforcement, there are still not enough PPNS to carry out investigations. Meanwhile, in society, there is a complexity of interests related to the economy, especially, thus ignoring the importance of controlling spatial planning for the sake of environmental sustainability and the welfare of people's lives. Obstacles in implementing law enforcement, namely 1). Not all regencies and cities in DIY have Spatial Planning Civil Servant Investigators (PPNS) 2). Limited Human Resources, 3). Not enough operational control regulations (not all regencies/cities in DIY has a Detailed Spatial Plan (RDTR).
