ABSTRACT

This community service program was held to provide motivation, understanding, and ability to high school history teachers in Bantul District on E-Learning Based Training in the pandemic era *COVID-19* and Assistance in Preparation of Higher Order Thinking Skill (HOTS) History Lessons for Teachers History of Bantul Regency High School. This activity also aims to 1) Motivate history teachers in implementing e-learning based learning in the pandemic era *COVID-19* and provide assistance in preparing Higher Order Thinking Skills (HOTS) history lessons, 2) Increase the understanding of history teachers in implementing learning e-learning based learning the preparation of Higher Order Thinking Skills (HOTS) history lessons, 2) Increase the understanding of history teachers in implementing learning learning e-learning based in the pandemic era *COVID-19* and mentoring the preparation of Higher Order Thinking Skills (HOTS) history lessons, and 3) Enhancing the abilities and technical abilities of history teachers in implementing e-learning based learning in the pandemic era *COVID-19* and mentoring compiling about Higher Order Thinking Skill (HOTS) history lessons.
