

# WONOLELO TOURISM DEVELOPMENT TRAINING BASED ON DISASTER RESILIENT VILLAGES

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## ABSTRACT

This training activity aims to increase community knowledge and skills in developing disaster-resilient village-based Wonolelo tourism. The target audience for the activity is people who are actively involved in tourism activities in Wonolelo with a target of 30 participants. Implementation of training activities uses lecture and practical methods. Lecture to explain knowledge about tourism, Wonolelo tourism potential and its development, disasters, disaster mitigation in Wonolelo based on disaster resilient villages, development of Wonolelo tourism based on disaster resilient villages, while practices for practicing disaster mitigation in support of Wonolelo tourism development in the form of evacuation simulations of the Merapi eruption disaster. Supporting factors for activities are support from local officials and training participants, while factors inhibiting activities are limited training time. Overall service activities can be said to be good, seen from the success of the target number of training participants (80%), achievement of training objectives (80%), achievement of planned material targets (80%), and participants' ability to master the material (75%). Community service activities can increase the knowledge and skills of training participants in developing disaster-resilient village-based Wonolelo tourism.
