

The Utilization of Internet for School Improvement

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ABSTRACT

The existence of school web or internet-supported learning is very likely to narrow the quality gap between education in urban areas and rural areas. One of the regions in Central Java Province that is now increasingly recognized for its potential because of social media is the Ngablak District, Magelang Regency. Management of information in rural areas in the district of Magelang has begun to use the internet to improve the community's economy, but so far it has focused more on the village economy. In line with the Digital Literacy Movement at the School piloted by the Ministry of Education and Culture in 2017, the use of the internet by schools has been done a lot but needs to be intensified and strengthened given the magnitude of the benefits of the internet when used appropriately. For this reason, the team implemented the community service program in the Educational Technical Service Unit of the Ngablak District, which was attended by 28 elementary school teachers in the area of Ngablak District. The form of PPM is face-to-face training and continued with online assignments with material focused on expanding learning resources and internet-based school publications. The purpose of this community service program is to provide teachers with an understanding of digital literacy, to provide knowledge and skills in web-based learning / elearning with an open source system to teachers and to provide school publication skills through school web and social media to teacher
