

**Directory of Thesis Research Themes of the Students of English Literature Study Program of the Faculty of Languages and Arts of Yogyakarta State University**

ABSTRACT

This study aims to 1) identify the themes of the thesis of the English Literature Study Program students from 2013-2015; 2) identify themes of the thesis proposals of the students of the English Literature Study Program in 2016; and 3) identify the faculty researches as umbrella themes for the student thesis research in 2016.

The method used in this research is descriptive qualitative, ie, by collecting and classifying the themes of students' researches in the given period, collecting and classifying the themes of the thesis proposals of the student, and determining the research umbrella themes for lecturers to involve students whose thesis have similar themes.

The themes of the students' thesis in Literature, field of feminism, psychoanalysis and sociology of literature became trend, whereas in Linguistics, pragmatics is chosen by most students, and in translation studies, analysis on the written translation became the most favorite topic compared to audio-visual text. While the Proposal of the Thesis submitted in the study of literature, psychoanalysis, feminism, sociology of literature, eco-criticism, and archetype still became the most chosen topics. In Linguistics, pragmatics remained the most favorite field. In Translation studies, the topics had a little progress in its variation.
