EDUCATION OF MANAGEMENT OF CHEMICALS IN DAILY LIFE FOR COMMUNITIES IN SLEMAN

ABSTRACT

This activity is carried out to overcome the problems faced by rural communities, namely an understanding of chemical management in daily life. One of the causes of this problem is that people do not get complete information formally or informally. This service activity aims to 1) provide knowledge about the dangers of chemical abuse in general, additives and B3 for human health and the environment, 2) provide an understanding of the importance of managing chemicals properly and safely, and 3) provide an understanding of how to provide first aid true and safe if an accident occurs due to exposure to B3.

Extension activities were carried out in the hamlets of Klepu and the hamlet of Sulihan, Sendangmulyo, Minggir, Sleman, DIY, on March 4, April 8, April 10, and May 6, 2018. This activity was attended by housewives, mothers of PKK members, and members farmers. The activity material includes: how to manage pesticides (Karim Theresih and AK Prodjosantoso), plastic (M. Pranjoto Utomo), preservatives (Regina Tutik P), coloring, flavoring, and flavoring (RR. Lis Permanasari), and how to make jam from papaya fruit (C. Budimarwanti).

This service activity is useful for adding knowledge, skills and experience to participants.
