ABSTRACT

This study aimed to describe the behavior of smoking among students of the Faculty of Social Sciences, Yogyakarta State University (UNY FIS), the reasons behind, and a sense of caring students who smoke to themselves, others, and the environment. This type of research is descriptive qualitative approach. The main data source is the research FIS UNY students who have the habit of smoking, male sex and willing to become informants research. The technique of collecting data using interviews, observation, and documentation. Researchers act as a research instrument with the help of interview guidelines and observation guidelines. Examination of the validity of the data using triangulation sources. Data analysis techniques using an interactive model of Miles and Huberman. The results showed that: 1) the implementation of policies in the FIS UNY ATR has not been effective; 2) Students FIS UNY smokers start smoking at the age under 15 years, there is even the age of 10 years; 3) their smoking behavior is caused by factors of inner and social environment; 4) they are less concerned about yourself and others when smoking on campus, 5) the behavior of respect and care must be imparted to the students so that they respect and protect the rights of nonsmokers.
