The purpose of this study was to develop a construction of performance assessment of sports learning outcomes of the game invasion of physical education learning outcomes in high school, and test the validity, reliability of the observation instruments of performance evaluation of physical education learning outcomes in high school. The research subjects used eleventh grade high school students. Content validation data analysis using Aiken's V formula, emperic validity using the producc moment formula, reliability between rater using Cronbach's Alpha. The results of the research in quantitative content validation and empirical validation show the validity of all items in the observation instrument of the performance evaluation of the learning outcomes of high school students' education. Besides that, it also shows the high interrater reliability of the observation instrument to assess the performance of high school students' learning outcomes.
