## **IPA-based Skills Products Workshop for Community Empowerment**

## **ABSTRACT**

The activities of the PPM aims to empower communities in the neighborhood boarding schools and orphanages so that participants (students and administrators) boarding schools and orphanages as well as the knowledge and skills gained can 1) made good products in the form of food or craft-based IPA; 2) doing a simple test against security of foodstuffs. The activities carried out by the method PPM lectures, demonstrations, practice as well as frequently asked questions, with measures of socialization, mentoring, monitoring and evaluation. Target audience in this activity is students and teacher in Pondok Pesantren Al Islah Panti Asuhan Mafaza 93 st Veteran road, Warungboto, Umbulharjo, as many as 22 people. Based on the activity that has been performed, the obtained results are as follows: 1) through socialization activities, participants (students and administrators) boarding schools and orphanages gain knowledge about how to make good food or craft-based IPA be making candy jelly, specimens in resin (bioplastic), ship security as well as knowledge about upa foodstuffs; 2) through practice and mentoring and monitoring, the participants (students and administrators/teachers)Pondok Pesantren and Panti Asuhan can make jelly candies, kerajian specimen in resin (bioplastic), steamers and do a simple test against security foodstuffs.
