MORAL VALUES IN CONTEMPORARY FRENCH FILM AND NOVEL

ABSTRACT

Moral values are one of the important components in a work of art such as novels and films. The purpose of this study is to describe moral values in the French contemporary film Pourris *Gâtés* by Nicolas Cuche and also the novel titled *Et Après* by Guillaume Musso. The research method used is descriptive interpretive by using data collection techniques in the form of reading, recording, classifying, coding and observing as well as using interpretive data analysis techniques. The results showed that the moral values contained in the two works are the values of cooperation, hard work, loyalty, compassion, brotherhood, and honesty.
