Strategy for Assisting Teacher Professional Development Through Classroom Action Research Training and Making Interactive Teaching Materials at SMA N 1 Polanharjo

ABSTRACT

This Community Service Program aims to provide an explanation regarding the process of preparing Classroom Action Research (PTK) proposals and reports, as well as providing knowledge to teachers regarding the steps for creating interactive learning media using flipbook-based applications. The target audience for this community service are school teachers at SMA N 1 Polanharjo Klaten. Participants who took part in the training were 79 teachers. The training method is carried out offline in the teacher's room at SMA N 1 Polanharjo Klaten and is carried out using lecture/question and answer and simulation/practice methods. The training is divided into two stages/sessions, namely training aimed at providing an explanation of how to make proposals and class action research reports. The second stage/session was carried out with material on making interactive learning media based on flipbooks accompanied by media making practices. The implementation of offline training activities went well and smoothly. The results of this training activity are first, participants can master the concept of making PTK proposals and reports in general. Second, participants can practice creating interactive learning media using flipbook media.
